Wednesday Night Bible class Scott is going through Knowing Jesus through the Old Testament by Christopher Wright.

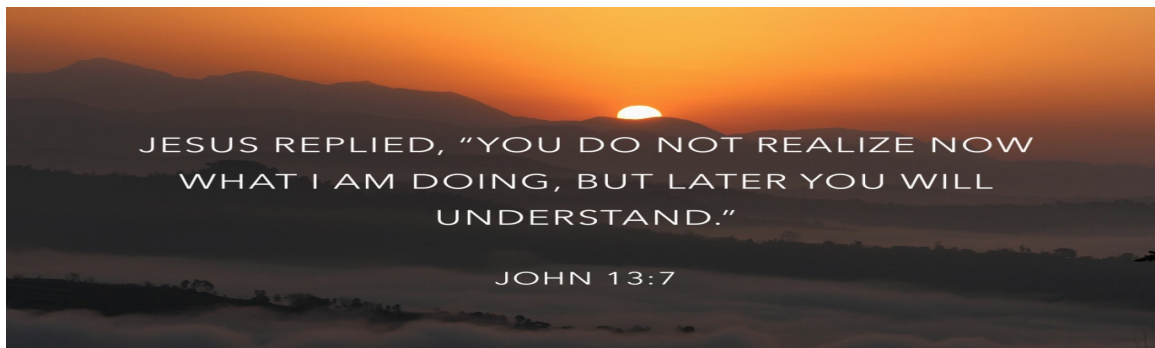
Prayers of Thanks
