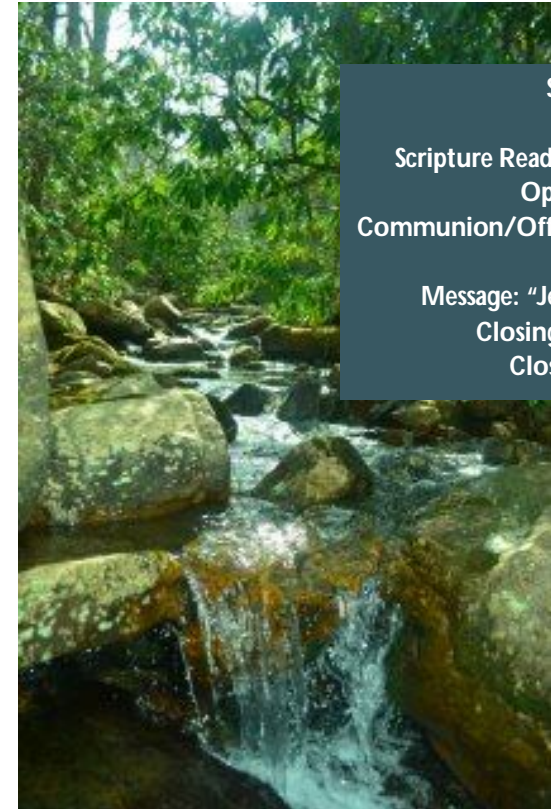

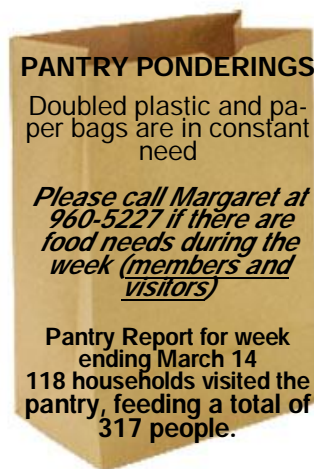
Dinner on the Grounds next week—Sunday, April 1
