2009 BUDGET UPDATE
 The budget for 2009, which has been late in being formulated, has been finalized, (except for a few minor tweaks). We apologize for the tardiness and promise to do much better next year. When we started looking at the budget in late 2008, we thought we would have to make some significant cuts in several budget categories based on our giving, as well as a reduction in our day-to-day cash on hand. The 2008 budget was \$1948,56 per week, and our overall average contribution for 2008 was \$1597.11 per week. However, the weekly giving for the last three months of 2008 averaged \$1744.45 per week. For the first three months, the weekly giving has greatly improved (\$2149.91 per week). Based on this change in our giving, the proposed 2009 budget will be roughly the same as 2008 (~\$1916 per week). We will have a short congregational meeting on April 19th after services to discuss and approve the budget (since 4/5 is Dinner on the Grounds and 4/12 is Easter). If you have any questions regarding the budget, please see Bill Werner.
