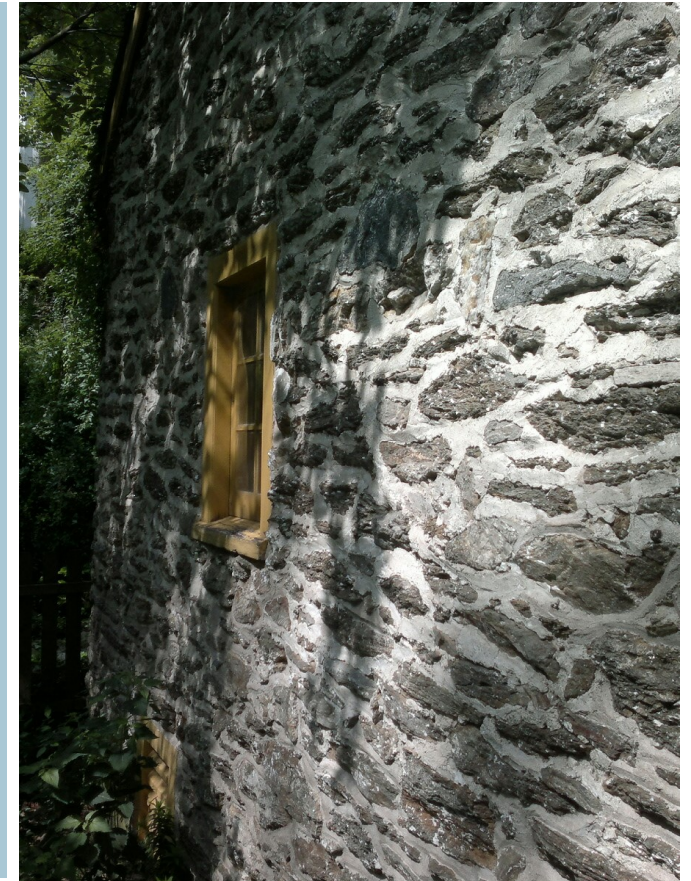

On May 21st 2016 the Church of Christ Oceanside Focus Group met to discuss the finances of the congregation. During the meeting we discussed the current budget, current level of giving, proposed budget changes, level of giving to support the hiring of an associate minister, and renovation of the Miller Building.

The current weekly budget is \$2,070.92, and our current level of giving (average of the last 10 months) is \$2,184.91, approximately 5% above budget. The Elders really appreciate the level of support the congregation is proving, this has allowed us to do some much needed repairs and improvements to the building and grounds.

This last year a lot of discussion and planning has been done with regards to hiring an associate minister and renovating the Miller Building. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss changes to the budget and consider the impacts for these two items. A proposed budget was put together by John Branard, Jim Conn, and Bill Werner, to reduce spending in most areas in order to make these items more attainable.

The first budget scenario was to make cuts to the current budget and then adding in the estimate of \$50K for an associate minister. The resulting budget would be \$2,416.21 a week, 17% above the current budget, or 12% above our current level of giving. **Note:** In this scenario approximately 75% of the cost is covered by budget cuts and 25% by increasing our contributions.

A second scenario was presented with the same budget cuts and adding in the renovation of the Miller Building which would currently require borrowing approximately \$100K. The estimated payments and cost for using the building (e.g. payments plus water and electricity) would result in a weekly budget of \$1,599.37, approximately 23% lower than our current budget.

A third scenario was presented with the budget cuts and adding in both, hiring of an associate minister and renovation of the Miller Building. The resulting budget would be \$2,607.06 per week, an increase of 26% above our current budget, and 21% above our current level of giving.

The resulting consensus (from votes taken during the meeting) is to bring the proposal for the budget cuts and hiring an associate minister to a vote at a family meeting. There was more than 90% support for this proposal from the Focus Group. There is some support for doing both; however the Elders do not see enough support at this time to ask the congregation for such a large increase in giving to do so. The Elders believe the Miller Building will play an important part in our future and will continue to hold the monies currently set aside for that purpose. Current balance in the account for the Miller Building fund is \$125,201.07. Also as giving continues to exceed our current needs we will periodically place monies that are above our current needs in the Miller Building fund to continue to save for a future renovation. Because we have been able to increase our reserves in our checking account this last year, we will proceed to move \$20K from our checking account to the Miller Building fund next week.
