CANS FOR HABITAT IS BACK

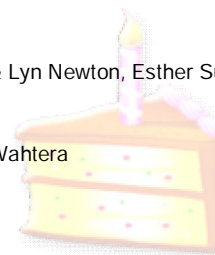
The boxes are back in the hall—teens are collecting empty, rinsed out, soda cans.
