Seeing Grace

Seeing all that Barnabas saw, what would he say to the church in Antioch? What would you say to a new and flourishing church like theirs? "He exhorted them all to remain faithful to the Lord with steadfast purpose" (Acts 11:23). As he watched and enjoyed the grace of God breaking out in Antioch, why would Barnabas charge them to remain faithful with steadfast purpose?

We all need to be reminded, again and again, to remain faithful with steadfast purpose — to not take tomorrow's faithfulness for granted, but to press in and be ready to "seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness" (Matthew 6:33). When a healthy soul witnesses grace, it makes him all the more hungry for grace, all the more dependent on God, all the more vigilant before temptation. True grace nurtures love where the weeds of laziness, selfishness, and pride might have grown.
