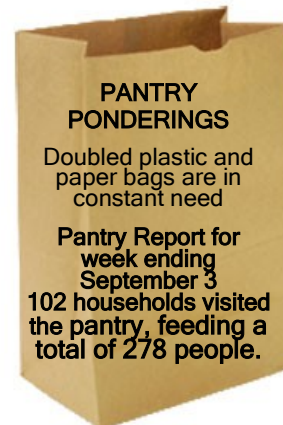
HELP WANTED !!!
