Save the Date

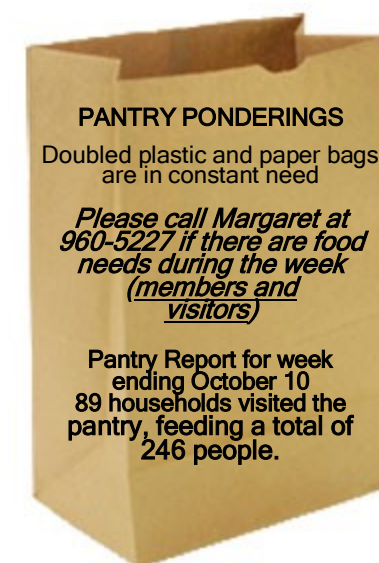
