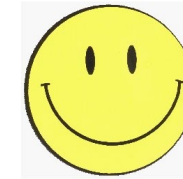
Sidney Williams, Jr. has taken a job as Administrative Judge in Washington, DC, but he would like a job in Richmond where he currently lives. Pray for him, please.
