

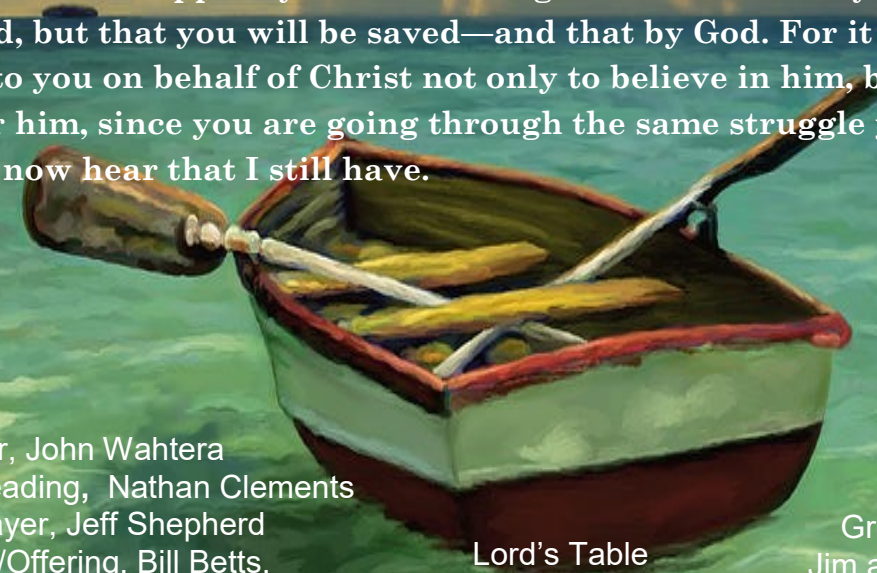

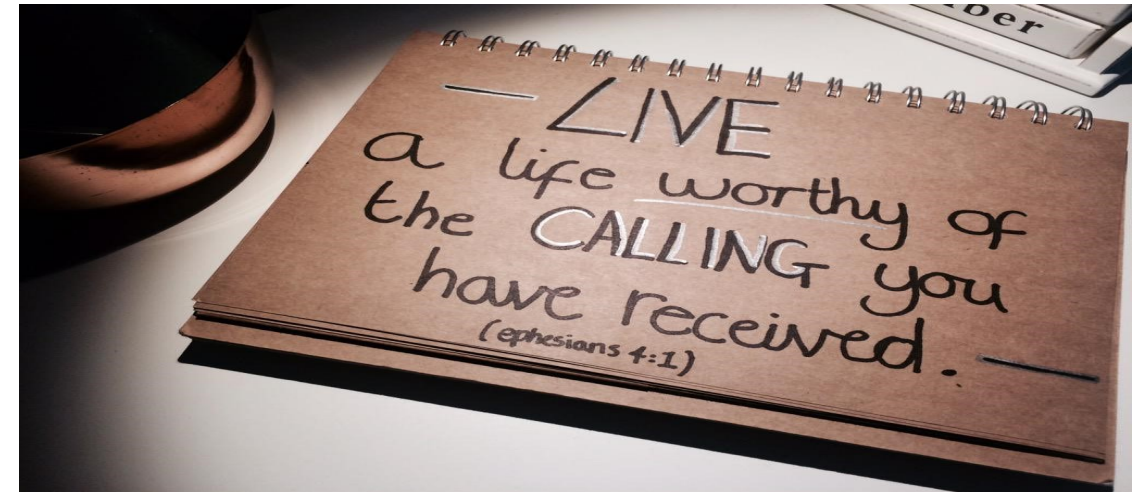
Welcome to the Family
