### IV. Jesus From the Last Letters

How do the latter letters of Paul describe Jesus?  
Matthew 28:18-20; Galatians 3:26-29; Ephesians 2:14-16  
Philippians 2:1-11; Romans 1:16-17; 3:21-22

There is a church mailbox in the main hallway. Please remember to check it for cards of encouragement, Christmas, birthday, anniversary, etc.

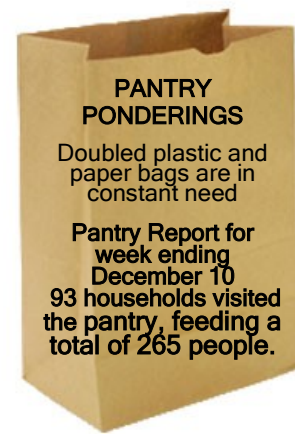
