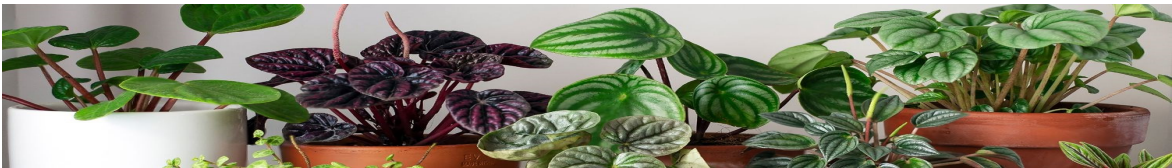
Congregational Meeting
