Wednesday Evenings 7:00-8:00—A study of the book of Psalms.

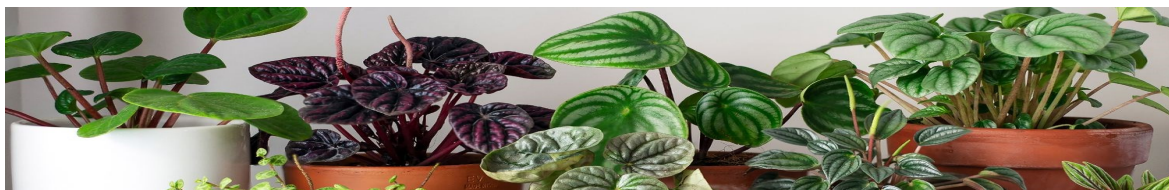
